Prayer Concerns:

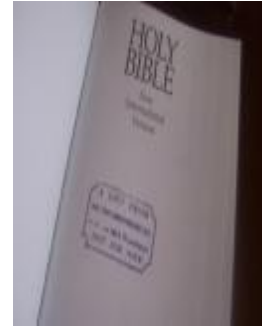
- Pray that the Lord will continue to raise up laborers as we continue to reach not only the city of Kampala but also Uganda for Christ.
